NATIONALISM OR GLOBALISM? CAN BE BOTH PART OF THE PROBLEM OR OF THE SOLUTION; THE IMPORTANT ISSUE IS: HOW TO FACILITATE THE DEVELOPMENT OF SUSTAINABLE NARRATIVES AND IDENTITIES?

Abstract: Nowadays we read a lot of commentaries about worrisome phenomena showing a growing number of examples about the destruction of human and natural capital deriving from the excesses of malignant nationalism and/or of the unforeseen extremes of globalization. But nationalism or globalism are the origin of our problems or something else more basic is at work

In my opinion nationalism and /or globalism are not at the origins of the growing problems facing us even if they can generate great harm. Historically are well known the dramatic lessons of the destructive impacts of the nationalistic deliriums of Fascism and Nazism on one side and the destructive impacts on human and natural resources of the globalist Marxist-Leninist dictatorships on the other. But equally destructive phenomena are the rampant forms of religious intolerance and theocratic apocalyptic narratives, that intertwine with terrorism and organized violence, not to speak of the destruction of the planet vast resources and ecological niches, the population bomb and an increasing compulsive consumerism accompanied by skyrocketing expectations based on wishful thinking and not on sustainable planetary capacities.

How to get out from this quagmire, since we live in a world that is largely our creation? We need to grasp how we are blinding ourselves and making ourselves impotent by disfunctionally employing obsolete ways of knowing and of coping. To retool our educational systems is a priority if we want to stop our self-destructive compulsive behaviors.

I think that Epistemic Communities like the World Academy of Art and Science and the World University Consortium can and should offer significant help to decision makers, opinion makers and all the stakeholders in understanding the complex processes of the social construction of the so called reality.
