

## CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

adopted on the symposium *Situation, Protection and Promotion of Human environment in Montenegro*, held in Herceg-Novi, October 6—8, 1976

### CONCLUSIONS

1. Reports and discussions on the Symposium mean an important contribution to the recognition of situation and of problems of protection and promotion of human environment in Monte Negro.

2. The Symposium pointed to the insufficient coordination and conformity of scientific researches and activity in this field on the territory of Monte Negro.

3. Various evaluations on the pollution levels of some environments and on the potential risk of certain pollution sources were stated on the Symposium.

4. The former activity in this field referred primarily to the recognition of situation and to the pollution level of certain environments, but the activity on establishing corresponding technological and other solutions for prevention of new focuses and for the sanitation of existing pollution sources was insufficient.

5. There is no register of air, ground, surface and underground waters polluters in the SR of Monte Negro.

6. The former investigations of pollution and their dynamism on all levels are incomplete and incomplex.

7. There is no institution in Monte Negro with appropriate staff and equipment for thorough investigations of air, ground, surface and underground waters pollution and also of consequences of such pollution.

8. The Symposium pointed to the insufficient coordination and synchronization of scientific and research work in the field of protection and promotion of human environment and of the consequences of such a situation.

9. Regulations, programs and projects on purposes and benefit of some places in certain regions of the Republic are insufficiently obeyed.

10. A higher engagement of socio-political organizations and strengthening of inspecting services on the application of laws from the field of protection of human environment is necessary.

11. The protection of underground waters of Monte Negro is of a special importance for the protection and promotion of human environment.

12. Further and more versatile investigations of natural wealths of Monte Negro for their appropriate protection and promotion are necessary.

13. No appropriate care is taken for the forest protection and regeneration.

14. The protection and promotion of human environment are of special importance for the nation-wide self-protection and for people's defence.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Materials from the Symposium, which represent an obvious contribution to the solution of this problemacy should be published.

2. A body on the republic level which will coordinate and plan scientific research and professional work in this field among, and with the help of, foreign organizations and scientific institutions from the Republic should be formed.

3. The investigation of the pollution level and consequences of such pollution should be continued and enlarged indispensably. A special engagement is necessary for prevention of appearance of new pollution sources and for the sanation of existing ones. Pooling of sources both of republic and communal self-managing communities of interest and of organizations of associated labour on the territory of the Republic is recommended.

4. Institutions and personnel for complex investigation of the air, ground, surface and underground waters should be formed and trained obligatorily.

5. Greater engagement of socio-political organizations and relative republic and communal agencies on a more consistent realization of adopted social standards in the field of protection and promotion of human environment is recommended.

6. A complex program of protection and promotion of human environment the realization of which will include all relative objects, phenomena and problems on the territory of Monte Negro is suggested to be made.

7. It is necessary to create material, personnel, technical and other conditions for protection, regeneration and promotion of forests and hunting on the whole and to work on the promotion and improvement of technology in the wood processing industry and so to spare the wood resources.
